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- Act to give effect to UN Convention on Rights of PWDs & matters
- Convention lays down following principles for empowerment of PWDs,
  - (a) respect for inherent dignity, individual autonomy including freedom to make one's own choices, & independence of persons;
  - (b) non-discrimination;
  - (c) full & effective participation & inclusion in society;
  - (d) respect for difference & acceptance of PWDs as part of human diversity
     & humanity;
  - (e) equality of opportunity;
  - (f) accessibility;
  - (g) equality between men and women;
  - (h) respect for evolving capacities of children with disabilities (CWDs) &
     respect for right of CWDs to preserve their identities

#### Categorization of Person with Disabilities –RPWDA 2016

- 2. (r) "person with benchmark disability" means a person with not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms & includes a PWD where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by certifying authority;
- (s) "**person with disability**" means a person with long term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairment which, in interaction with barriers, hinders his full & effective participation in society equally with others;
- (t) "person with disability having high support needs" means a person with benchmark disability certified under clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 58 who needs <u>high support</u>;
- (l) "high support" means an intensive support, physical, psychological & otherwise, which may be required by a person with benchmark disability for daily activities, to take independent and informed decision to access facilities & participating in all areas of life including education, employment, family & community life and treatment & therapy.

- PWDs shall have equal protection & safety in situations of risk, armed conflict, humanitarian emergencies & natural disasters. [Sec 8]
- No child with disability shall be separated from his or her parents on ground of disability except on order of competent court, if required, in best interest of child [Sec 9 (1)]
- If Parents unable to take care of a child with disability, competent court shall place such child with his or her near relations, failing that within community in a family setting or in exceptional cases in shelter home run by appropriate Govt or NGOs [Sec 9 (2)]
- No PWD shall be subject to any medical procedure leading to infertility without his or her free & informed consent [Sec 10 (2)]
- Election Commission of India & State Election Commissions shall ensure accessibility of polling stations & materials related to electoral process easily understandable to PWDs [Sec 11]
- Appropriate Govt shall ensure PWDs able to exercise right to access any court, tribunal, authority, commission or any other body having judicial or quasi-judicial or investigative powers without discrimination on basis of disability [Sec 12 (1)]

- Appropriate Govt shall
- ensure PWDs have right, equally with others, to own or inherit property, movable or immovable, control their financial affairs & have access to bank loans, mortgages and other forms of financial credit [Sec 13(1)]
- designate one or more authorities to mobilize community & create social awareness
   to support persons with disabilities in exercise of their legal capacity. [Sec 15 (1)]
- conduct survey of school going children in every 5 years for identifying children with disabilities, ascertaining their special needs & extent to which these are met:
  - 1st survey shall be conducted within a period of 2 years from date of commencement of Act;
- formulate schemes & programmes including provision of loans at concessional rates to facilitate & support employment of PWDs especially for vocational training and self-employment [Sec 19. (1)]

- Appropriate Govt may frame policies for posting & transfer of employees with disabilities. [Sec 20(5)]
- Every Govt establishment shall appoint a Grievance Redressal Officer for purpose of section 19 & shall inform Chief Commissioner or State Commissioner, as case may be, about appointment of such officer. [Sec 23(1)]
- Formulation of **Social Security Schemes** for adequate standard of living to PWDs with *quantum of assistance at least 25% higher than similar schemes* applicable to others [Sec 24(1)]
- Care-giver allowance to PWDs with high support needs [Sec 24(3i)]
- Comprehensive insurance scheme for PWD, not covered under Employees State Insurance Schemes, or any other statutory or Govt sponsored insurance schemes [Sec 24(3j)]
- Appropriate Govt shall, by notification, make insurance schemes for their employees with disabilities [Sec 26]

- Appropriate Govt shall take measures to
  - initiate research & development for empowerment of PWDs [Sec 28]
  - promote & protect rights of PWDs to have cultural life, to participate in recreational activities [Sec 29]
- ensure effective participation in Sporting activities [Sec 30]
- identify posts in establishments for persons with benchmark disabilities [Sec 33(i)]
- Constitute expert committee with representation of persons with benchmark disabilities for identification of such posts [Sec 33(ii)]
- undertake periodic review of identified posts at interval not exceeding 3 years [Sec 33(ii)]
- Develop schemes programmes to promote personal mobility of PWDs at affordable cost to provide for; [Sec 42 (2)]
  - (a) incentives and concessions; (b) retrofitting of vehicles; (c) personal mobility assistance.

- Under Rehabilitation Council of India Act, 1992, appropriate Govt shall endeavor to develop human resource [Sec 47 (1)] for that
  - Need based analysis & formulate plans for recruitment, induction, sensitization,
     orientation & training of suitable personnel [Sec 47(3)]
- Appropriate Govt shall undertake
  - Social audit of all general schemes & programmes involving PWDs to ensure need requirements & concerns of persons with disabilities [Sec 48]
  - Designate persons, having requisite qualifications & experience, as certifying authorities, who shall be competent to issue certificate of disability [Sec 57(1)]
- Constitution of **State Advisory Board** on disability [Sec 66(1)]
- Constitution of <u>district-level committee</u> on disability [Sec 72]
- Appointment of State Commissioner for PWDs [Sec 79(1)]
- Forming advisory committee (not more than 5 expert members) to assist State
   Commissioner [Sec 79(7)]

#### **Special Court**

- For purpose of providing speedy trial, State Govt shall, with concurrence of Chief Justice of High Court, by notification, specify for each district, a Court of Session to be a Special Court to try the offences under this Act. [Sec 84]
- For every Special Court, the State Government may, by notification, specify a Public Prosecutor or appoint an advocate, who has been in practice as an advocate for not less than 7 years, as a Special Public Prosecutor for purpose of conducting cases in that Court. [Sec 85 (1)]
- Constitution of State fund for PWDs by State Govt. [Sec 88 (1)]
